

INTERSTATES

I-85 spans the region, connecting Atlanta and Charlotte. 1-26 provides a direct route to the Port of Charleston. One-day truck service reaches 44% of the U.S. population.



PORTS

Accessibility to the Port of **Charleston and the Inland** Port Greer offer a significant advantage. Upstate businesses are in proximity to the deepest sea port in the Southeast, boasting the most productive crane moves per hour and a 60-minute truck turn time.

RAIL

Whether your company is receiving raw materials or shipping finished goods to market, the Upstate's wellconnected rail system can save companies time and money. Our region is served by major rail providers **CSX** and **Norfolk** Southern, with short-line services available

AIR

Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport (GSP) offers passengers departures to 17 major cities, with onestop access to the world. International cargo flights also benefit Upstate companies. Charlotte and Atlanta airports are only 1 to 2.5 hours away.




AN INNOVATION corridor

Innovation is the nucleus of the Upstate. Our industries are **patent-generating powerhouses**, backed by one of America's highest concentrations of engineering talent. Deemed **"The New Startup South"** by Bloomberg, our region is small in size though strong in its ability to meet industry needs.

Creators behind many of the Upstate's products — from Ryobi power tools to Prisma Health's VESper ventilator expander — benefit from collaborative innovation campuses and entrepreneurial support. Together, **industries and academic researchers are pioneering advancements** across fields from genetic discovery to light weighting materials. Industry-driven inquiry leads innovation in **packaging design** at Clemson University's Sonoco Institute. The Greenville Technical College Center for Manufacturing Innovation (CMI) explores **advancements of robotics in manufacturing**, and the International Transportation Innovation Center (ITiC) serves as a **proving ground for mobility innovation**.





CHANGING THE FUTURE OF CANCER CARE: KIYATEC

KIYATEC is shaping the future of cancer treatment with its 3D cell culture platform that models patient responses to cancer drugs, with applications for individual patient care and pharmaceutical development. The Greenville-based startup is a model of Upstate entrepreneurial support: founder Matt Gevaert began his research at Clemson University, and the company has grown since 2011 using support from the Clemson University Research Foundation's technology transfer office, Prisma Health's Institute for Translational Oncology Research (ITOR), SCRA Launch and more.

START-UP TO LARGEST MANAGED SERVICE PROVIDER

Healthcare data company ChartSpan exemplifies the Upstate's entrepreneurial potential. Founded in 2011 by brothers Jon-Michial Carter and Patrick Carter, a medical accelerator program drew the start-up to Greenville.

"After we got here, ... we said, 'This is a special place, and it would be foolish to leave.' It was an easy decision to stay," says Co-Founder Jon-Michial Carter.

NEXT Upstate's incubator space and business support network, along with access to capital, attracted the company to stay long after the accelerator program ended. And continued support from the SC Department of Commerce and Greenville Area Development Corporation helped them to grow. In 2016, ChartSpan established a downtown headquarters, with a planned 300 jobs.



Nurses, medical assistants and certified nursing assistants support ChartSpan's clients — physicians and medical practices who use the software to manage patients' chronic health conditions. The company has seen triple-digit revenue growth and raised more than \$37.2 million for scale-up.

A WORKFORCE that works

We take pride in the bright minds driving today's business success, and the talent pipeline preparing for tomorrow's opportunities. From industry-informed STEAM programs starting in early childhood to 200+ students pursuing graduate degrees in automotive **engineering**, education reigns supreme in the Upstate. 
