

Oconee County

The county was formed in 1868, and the county seat is Walhalla. This area was home to the Cherokees. who gave up their lands in treaties signed in 1777 and 1816. After the American Revolution, settlers from other parts of the state began moving in, including Germans from Charleston who founded Walhalla in 1850. Oconee County is in the foothills of the beautiful Appalachian Mountains and encompasses rivers. lakes, and forests. As one of South Carolina's most scenic and economically stimulating counties, Oconee County is situated in the northwestern corner of the state and is part of one of the nation's fastest growing areas, the I-85 Corridor. With a diversified economic base, Oconee offers a wide variety of and recreational opportunities. occupational The towns of Oconee County are also located on the South Carolina National Heritage Corridor, which extends from the Upstate to Charleston.



2018 Highest Education Attainment, Age 25+






